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CERTIFICATION:

The average length of the Teacher Training Program is three years of full, daytime attendance, but may be more or less depending on the experience and qualifications of the individual.

Following the completion of the Program requirements, a student will have successfully acquired their Intermediate and Advanced 1 Major Cecchetti examinations and will be entered for the *Associate teaching qualification exam with Cecchetti Canada - Cecchetti International Classical Ballet (CC-CICB).

*Associate of the CC-CIBC is an internationally recognized teaching credential.

ESB also offers training to upgrade for the following teacher credentials in the Cecchetti method:

Associate Diploma Licentiate Fellowship

It is also possible to study at ESB to achieve the following dancer exams in the Cecchetti method:

Advanced 2

Enrico Cecchetti Diploma

Additionally, ESB offers RAD Grades and Majors exam classes. TTP students are able to take these classes to be well-rounded in different ballet styles.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

Entrance is by ballet audition and interview.

A candidate must be at an Intermediate Major standard in Ballet. A mature candidate who is at one level below this may be conditionally considered for acceptance, but must be judged to show a true desire, maturity and responsibility.





TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAM:

Focus on Ballet, augmented with Modern Dance, Jazz & Tap

The Edmonton School of Ballet Teacher Training Program provides "KNOWLEDGE, EXPERIENCE and MENTORSHIP" to those individuals who, as teachers, desire to share their love of dance with others.

The Program encompasses theory, practice and experience in a broad range of dance disciplines, ensuring students graduate as a well-rounded, internationally qualified teachers.

During their time in the program, many Student Teachers are recommended for positions in local dance schools, thus gaining valuable experience and contacts while studying.

Student Teachers are constantly mentored, ensuring that ESB TTP candidates are highly sought after by local and surrounding area dance schools.

Classes are held at Edmonton School of Ballet located in Vimy Ridge Academy. Instructors are highly trained with professional credentials.
